



Fingerprint Painting

Get hands on with this activity, by letting your young people paint an animal by using just their fingers.

How?

A nice simple activity which anyone can do, regardless of their artistic skills.

For this activity you will need to print out some templates, which can be found below. These can be printed on either paper or card, however card may work best.

Set up some different coloured paints for your young people to use. To save on washing up, use paper plates which can just be thrown away after use.

All your young people need to do is dip their finger into the paint and then carefully dab their finger onto the template, where the circles are.

To keep the colours neat and separate, make sure you have paper towels handy for your young people to wipe paint off their fingers before changing colours.



Materials:

- Paint (various colours)
- Paper plates
- Printed templates
- Paper towels
