

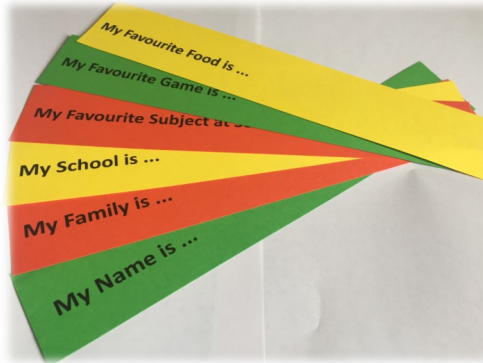


Getting to Know You Paper Chains

Get to know your young people better by creating these paper chains, made up of all their favourite things.

How?

To start this activity you will need to cut some coloured card into strips. Remember, these strips will need to be big enough to write on and long enough to make into chains.



Depending on the time you have for the activity and the age group you are working with, you may wish to do this beforehand.

Next your young people can start writing onto the strips of cards, information about themselves. Some suggested topics are:

Name	Favourite Food
Age	Favourite Game
Birthday	Favourite Animal
Family	Favourite Superhero
School	Favourite Movie

Once you have a number of strips of card completed, each young person can start making up their paper chain. To do this just loop the card around to form a circle (with the writing on the outside). Fix the loop with either glue, staples or sellotape. Each loop after that, just needs to be fed through the last hoop you made, to make a chain.

If you have time at the end, let each person tell the group what they have put on their paper chain

Materials:

- Coloured Card
- Pens
- Scissors
- Glue Stick / Stapler
