



Rainbow Cloud

A simple craft activity to do with Anchors / Juniors which looks great. This can be related to topics such as weather, Noah's ark, colours or just for fun!

How?

Gather your materials .
Depending on numbers / ages,
you may wish to pre-cut some of
the items.



Cut your paper plate in half to form your cloud. Once you have done this you can then cut the 7 colours of the rainbow. In this example I have used pieces of felt. Ensure all 7 colours are nice and even. If you have a large group you may want to pre-cut these.

Using a stapler, carefully staple each colour onto the plate. This would be a good chance to teach the order of the colours in a rainbow. Ensure a good even spread when attaching the strands to the plate.



Now you can spread your glue over the plate. Once you have done this, open up your cotton balls and stick them onto the plate to form the cloud.

Taking it a step further:

- Hole punch the top and attach string so it can be hung up.
- Teach your young people about the colours of the rainbow
- Link the rainbow to the story of Noah's ark and God's promise.



Materials:

- Paper plates
- Glue
- Scissors
- Cotton wool
- 7 Colours of the rainbow (can be felt, ribbon, card, paper etc)
- Stapler

Details:

Age - Anchors / Juniors
