



Splat!

A game which is really fun to play but requires no equipment, no preparation and very little explanation. A great way of filling a spare 5 minutes during your evening.

How?

Get your young people to stand in a circle and nominate one person to stand in the middle as the splatter.

Alternatively a leader could be in the middle.



The person in the middle must randomly point at somebody and shout 'SPLAT'. The person they aim at must immediately duck and the two people either side must then point at each other and shout splat. The last person to shout splat is eliminated from the game and must sit down.

This continues until there are just two people left in the circle. At this point they stand back to back. The person in the middle then counts from 1-20. Each time a number is called out the two players take a step away from each other.

At some point between 1 & 20 the caller will shout out splat instead of a number. When this happens, the two players must turn around, point at the other player and shout splat. The first to do so is the winner and becomes the new person in the middle.
