



Game - Water Bingo

An amusing and enjoyable game to play with your young people which will get them thinking on their feet to avoid getting sprayed with water.

How?

The aim of the game is for your young people to list items in a category (e.g colours, football teams etc). When an item matches with the leader of the games, the young person gets sprayed with water.



Equipment:

- Water Sprayer

Details:

Age - Anchors / Juniors

Time - 10 Minutes

Difficulty - 2/5



To play the game have your young people in a circle. Before the game, write down some categories and your item from that category. For example if your category is colours then you may chose your colour to be brown. Stand in the middle and go around the circle asking each member to name an item (Blue, red, green and so on). When a young person matches their item with the one you have written down then they lose the game and get sprayed.

Here are some category ideas: European countries, farm animals, TV shows, months of the year, boys names, numbers between 1-20, musical instruments, school subjects and so on.

Taking it a step further:

- Feeling brave? Let your young people take turns in picking the category and item and being in charge of the water sprayer. You may want to set a rule on how much water they are allowed to spray.
- Playing as part of teams? Keep a tally of who gets sprayed. The teams with the least water sprays are the winners.
